

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PALM SPRINGS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT A UTILITY EASEMENT TO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON

WHEREAS, the Palm Springs Unified School District (“District”) is the owner of certain real property located at 68-850 Pierson Blvd., Desert Hot Springs, CA 92240 known as Desert Hot Springs High School (“Property”);

WHEREAS, the District received a grant from Southern California Edison (“SCE”) for the installation of 12 EV charging stations and associated equipment (collectively, the “Equipment”) at the Property;

WHEREAS, SCE requires an easement to install and access the Equipment on the Property and specifically the area further identified in the proposed easement attached hereto as Exhibit A (“Easement”);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17556, the governing board of a school district may dedicate or convey to the state, or any political subdivision of municipal corporation thereof, for utility purposes, any real property belonging to such school district upon such terms and conditions as the parties thereto may agree;

WHEREAS, the District desires to provide the Easement to the SCE on the Property as set forth in the Easement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17557, the School District’s governing board must, prior to dedicating an Easement, adopt a resolution declaring its intention to dedicate such Easement in a regular open meeting by two-thirds (2/3) vote of all of its members;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17557, the School District’s governing board must fix a time at its regular place of meeting for a public hearing upon the question of making the dedication of the Easement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Code section 17558, the School District is required to post copies of this Resolution, signed by the board, in three (3) public places within the School District’s boundaries not less than ten (10) days before the public hearing, and publish notice once, not less than five (5) days before the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation published in the School District, if there is one, or, if there is no such newspaper published in the School District, then in a newspaper published in the county which has a general circulation in the School District.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the Palm Springs Unified School District as follows:

1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

2. That the School District's governing board declares its intent to dedicate the Easement to SCE upon the terms and conditions set forth in the recitals.

3. That the Board establishes May 23, 2023 for a public hearing on the question of the School District's intent to dedicate the Easement to SCE.

4. The School District staff shall post this resolution in three (3) public places within the School District's boundaries and publish notice of the adoption of this Resolution in compliance with Education Code section 17558.
