A Student Art Show in Collaboration with the Department of Visual & Performing Arts at Palm Springs Unified

Palm Springs Art Museum and Palm Springs Unified School District invite you to submit an original work of art that addresses the theme **Imagine an Antiracist Future**.

The juried exhibition is open to middle and high school students attending PSUSD. Selected works will be exhibited in the Annenberg Wing at the museum **February 17 - March 31, 2022**.

Criteria for Submission and Consideration:

- All submissions must address the exhibition theme: Imagine an Antiracist Future
- Each artist must submit a typed artist statement that will be on view during the exhibition.
 - Please include the artist's name, grade, title of work, school, and teacher, as well as a statement about of the artwork that is no more than 150 words.
- Two-dimensional work in any media is acceptable.
 - o Works may be no larger than 40" h x 30" w.
 - o Selected works will be framed by PSUSD.
- The due date for submitting works is **January 28, 2022**.

Please Note:

- All works of art must be original.
- No organic or loose materials may be used (i.e., flowers or sand).
- All submitted artworks must be on exhibition-ready materials.
- Each school must submit photos of artworks digitally online through Google Drive.
 - o Image files must be formatted in .jpg. Please no PDFs, .gif, .tiff, or .bmp.
 - Each image must be labeled with the school, artist's last name, first name, and title.
 (example: PSHS Smith John Untitled.jpg)



Submissions will be judged by the following criteria:

- Significant and thoughtful investigation of the theme
- Meaningful use of materials
- Exploration of art practices including, but not limited to, new media, techniques and concepts
- Imaginative communication of ideas and/or emotions
- Quality craftsmanship
- 5-10 works will be selected by PSAM and PSUSD staff, and will be announced to instructors on January 20, 2022.
- Selected works are to be dropped off at the District Arts Office, Rancho Mirage High School, 31001 Rattler Road, Rancho Mirage,

CA 92270 on February 3 or 4, 2022.

All exhibiting students and art instructors will receive a one-year membership to Palm Springs Art Museum.
