- * Awards a \$3,000 college scholarship to every cadet who graduates from DHSHS and continues their education at College of the Desert. \$9,000 scholarships given to cadets accepted at any 4 year school.
- * Sends 4 cadets to Texas A&M
 University each summer to attend a 7
 day national drill camp. All expenses are paid by the MCJROTC Program.

 *Sends ten cadets each summer to Camp.
- *Sends ten cadets each summer to Camp Camp Pendleton for 10-day Devil Pups Training.

History

The Marine Corps Junior ROTC Program was established at Desert Hot Springs High School during 2000. DHSHS possesses the only Marine Corps JROTC Program in the Coachella Valley.

The Marine cadets have won the "Superintendent's Trophy" for Best JROTC Program within the school district for the last eight years. Headquarters Marine Corps has designated Desert Hot Springs as a "Naval Honor School" since 2011. This distinction is only awarded to the top 20% of Marine JROTC Programs nationwide on an annual basis.

As the result of donations provided by veterans and veteran organizations, the Marine cadets at DHSHS are able to participate in field trips to MCB, Camp Pendleton; MCAGCC, Twentynine Palms; MCLB, Barstow; MCRD, San Diego; NAB, Coronado, and NAF, El Centro. No charges or fees are paid by Marine cadets to participate in these activities.
