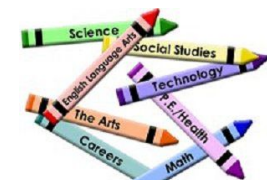
School Site Council

- The School Site Council (SSC) provides input and guidance to the school's administration on developing the contents of the SPSA – School Plan for Student Achievement.
- The SPSA is updated annually, including proposed expenditure of funds allocated to the school, including Title 1 funds.
 - Administration, Staff and Parents on the SSC work together as an educated voice in the purchase and implementation of these funds.



Bubbling Wells is a Title I school

- **What does that mean?**
 - Each year, Bubbling Wells gets money from the federal government to help bridge the learning gaps low-income and other at-risk students often experience.



What does BWES do with the money?

- Title 1 funds can be used:
 - To provide program improvements to meet the needs of students who are at-risk, including: improving access to curriculum & instructional strategies, increased staffing support, access to counseling/mental health, and increased parental involvement.
- Bubbling Wells uses these funds to support:
 - Parent Involvement – translation, family nights, parent education trainings
 - Classroom Instructional Support
 - Academic Coach and Paraprofessionals

English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC)

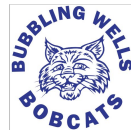
- ELAC is a committee of parents and other community members who want to support English Language Learners and their families.
- The ELAC advises the School Site Council on programs and services to meet the current needs of our BW English Learners (EL's)


Expectations for Students

Parent Tips:
How to support your child in zoom meetings



THE DO'S

- Choose a quiet area to help your child get logged into clever or their zoom class
- Tell your child that it is ok if they experience technical difficulties they can just close and open windows again
- Ask your child about their learning experience at the end of the day

THE DON'TS

- Do not attend zoom class with your child
- Do not speak to any other students in the zoom class
- Do not engage with the teacher during class
- Do not hesitate to email your child's teacher with questions or concerns

- Attendance



- School attendance is important for consistency in your child's education. Missing excessive days of online and independent learning could potentially hinder your child's learning.
