

4. How to Calculate Midterm & Final Exam

Using ALEKs Progress

Example:

Suppose:

- 10 lessons Learned
- 60 lessons Mastered
 Out of a total of 178 lessons

So,

complete in ALEKs

You need to be <u>50% complete</u> at the end of your IM S1 classes.

Your ALEKs final grade will be 39.3/50 = 78.6%
