Puttanesca Sauce Recipe

Ingredients: Large tin of Roma tomatoes in juice; small tin of anchovies; Kalamata olives: capers: garlic cloves; protein of choice (chicken, shrimp, oysters, clams); salt and pepper, red chili flakes.

Method: Chop up garlic and fry in a small amount of olive oil; Add the tin of tomatoes with juice to the garlic; Use a pair of scissors to cut up the whole tomatoes in the pan; Add the oregano and chili to taste and stir over medium heat for several minutes. Chop up anchovy filets and add them to the tomato sauce; Cut the olives in half and add them to the pan; Add the capers to the tomato sauce and simmer for 5-10 minutes. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Add protein of choice and simmer for 10-15 minutes until protein is thoroughly cooked . Serve over pasta of choice and grated parmesan cheese.
