-in almost 5,000 schools and serving over 1,000,000 students!






WHAT IS AN AVID STUDENT?

Expectation/Criteria

- 1. Academic success in middle school courses.
- 2. Maintain satisfactory citizenship and attendance in all classes
- 1. Maintain appropriate behavior that exemplifies characteristics of a motivated student.
- 2. Receive C's or above on report cards and progress reports.
- 3. Maintain an AVID three-ring binder with an agenda and, assignments in all classes.
- 4. Complete all homework assignments.
- 5. Participate in AVID tutorials, field trips, family nights, fundraisers and evening activities.

ÁVID

James Workman Middle School AVID Application

AVID is an elective class offered to students who would like to prepare for a four-year university or career. The curriculum features writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, reading, note-taking and study skills, college/career/motivational activities. Facilitators are in the classroom twice a week, and field trips are taken to universities in the area. Students must commit to taking notes in core subject areas. Other requirements for applications are satisfactory citizenship, good attendance, and a GPA of 2.0-3.5.

What is AVID?

AVID targets students in the academic middle – B and C students - who have the desire to go to college and the willingness to work hard. These are students who are capable of completing rigorous curriculum. Typically, they will be the first in their families to attend college, and many are from low-income or minority families. AVID pulls these students out of their unchallenging courses and puts them on the college track: acceleration instead of remediation. This requires true INDIVIDUAL DETERMINATION to work hard in school to reach their goal of attending college.

For one period a day, they learn organizational and study skills, work on critical thinking and asking probing questions, get academic help from peers and college tutors, and participate in enrichment and motivational activities that make college seem attainable.

* WHY DO WE ASK?

AVID gives priority to students who are traditionally underrepresented in 4-year colleges. This information helps us determine which students will likely benefit most from our program in the case of limited space. Your answers in this section do not disqualify you from acceptance.
