

**Global Operational Expectation**

The Superintendent shall not cause, allow, or fail to take reasonable measures to prevent any practice, activity, decision or organizational condition that is unlawful, unethical, unsafe, imprudent, in violation of Board policy or endangers the organization's public image or credibility.
