NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Projec	t Name:	Palm Springs High School Seismic Upgrades and Modernization Improvements
Projec	t Description:	The Palm Springs Unified School District (PSUSD) is proposing to implement various seismic upgrand modernization improvements on the Palm Springs High School (PSHS) campus (proper Project). Of those buildings that would undergo seismic upgrades and modernization improvem as part of the proposed Project include the: (1) library; (2) gymnasium; and (3) cafeteria. proposed Project would include the renovation of these 3 buildings to meet current seistandards modernization improvements, as well as the construction of a new 7,400-square-mini-gym within the cafeteria and the addition of a 1,950-square-foot lobby on the northeast co of the gymnasium. Lastly, the proposed Project would involve various hardscape and landscape improvements across the PSHS campus to improve existing drainage conditions. Implementation the proposed Project would provide the PSHS campus with a range of upgraded and modern facility that meet current standards. Construction of the proposed Project would take approximately months, with a commencement date of spring 2020 and an estimated completion date of sum 2022. Occupancy of the upgraded and modernized facilities would occur by the start of the 20203 school year.
Project	t Location:	The PSHS campus is located at 2401 East Baristo Road and immediately adjoins the Desert Learn Academy (DLA) campus on a joint campus. The PSHS-DLA joint campus is bound by East Baristo R to the north, South Farrell Drive to the east, East Ramon Road to the south, and South Pavilion V to the west. The Project site, which consists PSHS portion of the campus, is currently comprise approximately 20 buildings situated across a total area of approximately 43 acres.
