LCAP:

extra budget will need to be added to certificated stipends (\$6,000) , this money will be pulled from consultants. Less finding someone and more allowing teachers the time to work.

Over budgeted on bilingual support, so there is extra money that can be moved.

Money would like to be moved to material and supplies. (\$25,000 to buy a poster maker and a dicut and other supplemental supplies)

Professional Development & Collaboration (high impact math) is over budgeted so some money will be pulled and put into materials and supplies as well.
