



National Scholarships

1) Center for Cyber Safety and Education

• (ISC)² Womens Cybersecurity Scholarship

- ❖ Plan to pursue a degree with a focus on cybersecurity or information assurance.
- ❖ GPA must be at least 3.3
- ❖ You may be a citizen of any country (US citizenship not required)
- ❖ Awards will be disbursed until the recipient is enrolled in a college or university.

Deadline: February 22, 2021

• (ISC)² Information Security Undergraduate Scholarship

- ❖ Plan to pursue a degree with a focus on cybersecurity or information assurance.
- ❖ GPA must be at least 3.3
- ❖ You may be a citizen of any country (US citizenship not required)
- ❖ Awards will be disbursed until the recipient is enrolled in a college or university.

Deadline: March 8, 2021

• KnowBe4 Women in Cybersecurity Scholarship

- ❖ Must be a female planning to pursue a degree with a focus on cybersecurity, information assurance or similar field.
- ❖ GPA must be at least 3.3
- ❖ Must be a US citizen or permanent resident in the United States.

Deadline: February 22, 2021

• KnowBe4 Scholarship for Black Americans in Cybersecurity

- ❖ May be a male or female planning to pursue a degree with a focus on cybersecurity or information assurance.
- ❖ GPA must be at least 3.2
- ❖ Must be a US citizen.

2) Norman Brown Scholarship

- ❖ Applicants should be an identified member of one of the following groups: Black/African American, Native American/American Indian, Hispanic/Latin American, Asian or Pacific Islander.
- ❖ GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- ❖ Attending a 4 year college or university.
- ❖ Citizenship is required.
- ❖ Applicant's family's income must be at or below the national poverty level based on family size for the current year.

3) DCU for Kids Scholarship

- ❖ Be registered and attend a state-accredited or nationally accredited two or four-year college or university in the fall of 2021.

- ❖ 500-800 word essay responding to one of the prompts listed on the website.
- ❖ Legal resident.
- ❖ Must enroll in a post-secondary institution of higher education (2 or 4 year college or university, trade school, online or vocational school program).

5) Amazon Black Employee Network Scholarship

- ❖ Self-identify as Black or person of African descent.
- ❖ Plan to enroll in full time undergraduate study at an accredited four-year college or university.
- ❖ Plan to pursue a computer science or supply chain-related field of study and career*
- ❖ Have a minimum unweighted grade point average of 3.0

6) Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation

- **Undergraduate & Associate Degree Scholarship** (Scholarship for undergraduate students at every level)
 - ❖ Children of Marines and Navy Corpsmen, Chaplains, and Religious Program Specialists (See website for more information)
 - ❖ Minimum GPA of 2.0
 - ❖ Family adjusted gross income for the 2020 tax year that does not exceed \$106,000.
- **Career & Technical Education Scholarship** (Scholarship for students planning to attend a non-degree certificate program that is less than 12 months)
 - ❖ Children of Marines and Navy Corpsmen, Chaplains, and Religious Program Specialists (See website for more information)
 - ❖ Minimum GPA of 2.0
 - ❖ Family adjusted gross income for the 2020 tax year that does not exceed \$106,000.
 - ❖ Planning to attend a college or career training school listed on the *National Center for Education Statistics College Navigator* website in the 2021-22 academic year.

7) Amazon Future Engineer Scholarship

- ❖ Be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.
- ❖ Be planning to attain a bachelor's degree in computer science, software engineering, computer engineering or other computer science related field of study from an accredited 4-year college or from a 2-year college with the intent to transfer to a 4-year college.
- ❖ Be high school seniors who are currently enrolled in or who have completed a high school or college dual degree course where computer science is the subject. (Examples online)
- ❖ Minimum 3.0 GPA.

8) National HACEMOS Scholarship Program

- ❖ Be of Hispanic heritage.
- ❖ High school seniors who plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the United States, Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands, Guam or any other U.S. territory for the entire 2021-22 academic year.
- ❖ Enroll in at least 12 credit hours per semester in coursework leading to a degree.
- ❖ Minimum GPA 3.0
