Single Unit Control

The Board will direct the Superintendent only through official decisions of the Board.

- 1. The Board will make decisions by formal, recorded vote in order to avoid any ambiguity about whether direction has been given.
- 2. The Superintendent is not obligated to follow the directions or instructions of individual Board members, officers and committees unless the Board has specifically delegated such exercise of authority.
- 3. Should the Superintendent determine that an information request received from an individual member or a committee requires a material amount of staff time or is unreasonable, the Superintendent may refuse such requests and ask that the committee or the member refer such requests to the Board for authorization.
